7. Sam has 3 1p pieces in his pocket. How much money does Sam have altogether?
8. Mo has 4 bags of marbles with 5 marbles in each bag. Susie has 3 bags of marbles with 10 marbles in each bag. Who has the most marbles?
9. Bananas are 10p each. Priya wants to buy 7 bananas. She has 125 p pieces. Does she have enough money? Explain your answer.
