Write your own short story about a 'girl with a curl' - try

Follow-up activity after lesson:

Option 1: Shopping basket activity. Can you solve the counting on and backwards questions to answer how much the items will cost?

Option 2: How much money is in my piggy bank? Recognise the coins in the piggy bank and count the money to find the answers.

Extra challenge: Next time you go to the shop, help your adult with counting the money for their shopping and recognise the coins used to pay with.

Take a step back: Piggy bank counting to 20. Draw the coins in the piggy bank.


Follow-up activity after lesson:
