<p><b>Extra challenge</b> Read the words and colour them according to if they are real words or alien words.</p> <p><b>Take a step back</b> Practise sounding out simple 'f' words such as - fog, fat, frog, fish.</p>	<p><b>Extra challenge</b> <b>Add single-digit and 2-digit numbers, identifying patterns in units digits</b> Children choose a number bond they like, e.g. 4 + 5. They write four variations of this bond, that is, <math>\square \square + \square = \square</math> e.g. <math>24 + 5 = 29</math>, <math>44 + 5 = 49</math>, etc. Use a 100-square to help if required. Encourage children to move on to making generalisations, e.g. <math>1\ 000\ 004 + 5 = 1\ 000\ 009</math>.</p>
