For the follow up work, make some binoculars and have a look around to see what you can see! Write a sentence about what you can see.</li> <li>• Take a train for a ride and read the 'ee' words on your train track.</li> <li>• Use your phonic cards to make some of your own 'ee' words. Are they real words or Beegu words?</li> </ul> | <p><b>Maths:</b> We look forward to you joining us for maths at: <b>10.15am or 10.45am</b> (please see email invite for specific time)</p> <p><b>Repeating patterns</b></p> <p>Today we learnt about repeating patterns of colours.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can you make your own repeating patterns using colours?</li> <li>• Complete the repeating pattern of colours using the learning sheets online.</li> </ul> | <p><b>Topic:</b> We look forward to you joining us at: <b>1.15pm or 1.45pm</b> (please see email invite for specific time)</p> <p><b>Vets</b></p> <p>Today we have been learning how vets help our families.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Draw a picture of your pet that has been helped by the vet. | <p>Spend some time learning to read these common words. The pink words are <b>fairy words</b> and the green words are <b>tricky troll words</b>. If possible, we'd love to see a video of you reading... upload this onto tapestry if you can!</p>  | <p>Practise skipping, either with a rope or without: Bronze: 2 minutes Silver: 5 minutes Gold: 7+ mins</p> <p>Catch a ball with your OTHER hand: Bronze: 15 catches Silver: 25 catches Gold: 35 catches</p> <p>Try dribbling a ball, or some socks, around your yard. Make yourself an obstacle course to kick it around.</p>   |
