As always, if you get stuck or technology does not work, don't worry. There is lots of learning you can still do, but it is important that you do some learning every day so that we don't get behind.



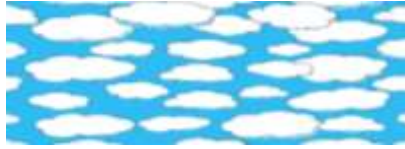
