Your task this afternoon is to make a clock. You could use the print out online or use your imagination to build one. You will need to use this clock in your maths lessons so it must have moveable hands.</p>

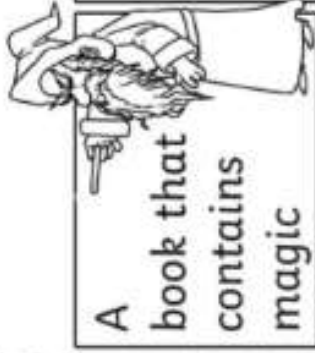
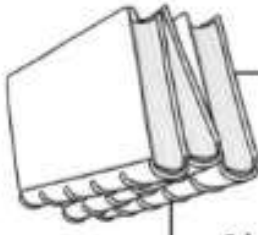
