Live Lessons (via Teams)

<p>Phonics: Today there are no online sessions.</p> <p>Your work for today is to play eye spy. Either using the sheet below, or spying on things around you, sound out the object that you can see. Eg, "I spy a c-a-t", "I spy a b-ir-d"</p>	<p>Maths: Today there are no online sessions.</p> <p>Your maths work for today is to create a repeating pattern using anything that you want. You could create a pattern using coins and buttons or maybe you could go outside and create a pattern using leaves and twigs!</p>	<p>Topic: Today there are no online sessions.</p> <p>Today I would like you to do a book review of your favourite book. You could write a sentence about your favourite book, draw a picture of the main character or draw a picture of the front cover. Bring the book along to Thursdays story session to share with the class.</p>

<p>Spend some time learning to read these common words. The pink words are fairy words and the green words are tricky troll words. If possible, we'd love to see a video of you reading... upload this onto tapestry if you can!</p>	<p>Practise skipping, either with a rope or without: Bronze: 2 minutes Silver: 5 minutes Gold: 7+ mins</p> <p>Catch a ball with your OTHER hand: Bronze: 15 catches Silver: 25 catches Gold: 35 catches</p> <p>Try dribbling a ball, or some socks, around your yard. Make yourself an obstacle course to kick it around.</p>

- Eye Spy - play a game of eye spy using the sheet below. Sound out the objects that you have spied (c-a-t, d-o-g, s-o-ck). Can you blend the sounds together to create the word?
- Play a game with my family, where we have to take it in turns - maybe monopoly, snakes and ladders or noughts and crosses
