**Live Lessons (via Teams)**

**English:** I look forward to you joining us for English at:

**9.15am or 9.45am**

Today we will be reading the second page of text.

**Follow up activity after lesson:**

Click on 11.1.21 English independent task. Underline or copy words and phrases on to paper that help you to visualise what is happening in the story. Draw, paint, colour, sketch a picture to show what the text is describing. Annotate around the edge of your picture the evidence you have collected that helped you to know what to draw. Have your pictures ready to share in our lesson tomorrow when I will reveal the book image.

**Maths:** I look forward to you joining us for maths at:

**10.15 or 10.45**

Today we are working on negative numbers.

**Follow-up activity after lesson:**

Click on 11.1.21 Maths independent task. Have a go at either the bronze, silver or gold questions like you would in class. You don’t have to print them out, just write your answers on a piece of paper. There is also a challenge to try if you want to. After you have had a go at the questions, you or an adult can mark them. Anything you aren’t sure about we can go through tomorrow.

**Topic:** I look forward to you joining us at:

**1.15 or 1.45**

Today we will be starting our Extreme Planet geography topic and looking at the layers of the Earth.

**Follow-up activity after lesson:**

Click on 11.1.21 Topic independent task. Choose your challenge: bronze or silver/gold. Draw a cross-section of Earth and label the layers. Colour it. Then, write a short description/definition of each layer. Extra task – if you have plastercine or playdough or clay at home you could make a model of Earth and its layers. See the instructions on the website with the other resources.

**Spellings**

This week’s Spellings are: **neighbour, nuisance, occupy, occur** and **opportunity**.

Practise writing your spellings in as many different ways as you can eg: writing, drawing, typing, with sticks, chalk, paint, pens. Why not have a go at one of the activities below?

**Make some Music** – Write a song or a rap that includes your words! Share with a friend or family member.

**Match Up** – Write each word and their definition on separate cards. Turn all the cards face down and mix them up. Lay out your cards in rows and flip over 2 cards at a time. Read each card aloud to see if they match. Keep them if they match or flip over and try again.

**Reading**

**Read for at least 10 minutes. It could be a chapter of a book, a magazine, a newspaper, a recipe or instruction book, an information book etc. You choose!**

Summarise the events from the chapter or a short story you have read today. You could bullet point what happened, create a comic strip or present the information in your own creative way.

Remember it is only the key points! You don’t need all the details and description.

**Be Active**

**Have a go at one of these activities:**

**Dance** – Put your favourite songs on and create a routine, bust your best moves or play a game of musical statues!

**Create an obstacle course or home circuit** – raid the cupboards for some tins of beans to use as weights, a pillow as something to jump over or the stairs as a hill!



### Other Curriculum Learning

**After your topic lesson, you could have a go at one of these activities:**

**History** – The Shang Dynasty – Lesson 1 - How do we know about the Shang Dynasty? Have a go at the 23-minute session. You will find out where the Shang Dynasty was in the world, what archaeologists do, learn how to do some ancient Chinese writing and finally look at some artefacts they have found. The lesson will end with a quiz. You will need a pencil, paper and your brain! [How do we know about the Shang Dynasty? \(thenational.academy\)](https://thenational.academy)

**Screen Free Time** – Make a Nature Collage – Collect natural objects found outside, such as leave, twigs, pine cones and flowers. Create a scene by using them to make a collage.
