Live Lessons (via Teams)

English: I look forward to you joining us for English at:
9.15am or 9.45am
 Today we will be completing a role on the Wall for the main character Jub.
Follow up activity after lesson:
 Click on 12.1.21 English independent task. Complete the Role on the Wall activity. Write any words or phrases you think/know about Jub's feelings and personality on the inside of the outline. Write any words or phrases about Jub's appearance, facts or other information on the outside of the outline.

Maths: I look forward to you joining us for maths at:
10.15 or 10.45
 Today we are working on Roman numerals.
Follow-up activity after lesson:
 Click on 12.1.21 Maths independent task. Have a go at either the bronze, silver or gold questions like you would in class. You don't have to print them out, just write your answers on a piece of paper. There is also a challenge to try if you want to. After you have had a go at the questions, you or an adult can mark them. Anything you aren't sure about we can go through tomorrow.

Science: I look forward to you joining us at:
1.15 or 1.45
 Today we will be learning about different forces that act on objects.
Follow-up activity after lesson:
 Click on 12.1.21 Science independent task. Choose your challenge: bronze or silver/gold. Read the information about Isaac Newton and his discovery. Remember to answer in sentences with capital letters and full stops. Once you have answered the questions, you or an adult can check your answers and do any corrections as needed.

Spellings

This week's Spellings are: **neighbour, nuisance, occupy, occur** and **opportunity**.
 Practise writing your spellings in as many different ways as you can eg: writing, drawing, typing, with sticks, chalk, paint, pens. Why not have a go at one of the activities below?
Scrabble – Use scrabble tiles to spell out your spelling words. For a little extra maths practise figure out the point value of each of your words!
Sign Your Words – Use sign language finger spelling to sign the spelling of your words. Watch the [youtube video](#) to learn the alphabet.

Reading

Read for at least 10 minutes. It could be a chapter of a book, a magazine, a newspaper, a recipe or instruction book, an information book etc. You choose!
 Note down any unfamiliar words from what you have read today. Explore the meanings of these words by using a dictionary and reading around the sentence.

Be Active

Have a go at one of these activities:
 Do you or a sibling(s) have a **ball pit**? How long does it take you to empty the balls (only using your hands and not touching the pit) Try it one handed, try only taking some colours out at a time, try it only using your feet! Turn it into a family competition! 😊
 Can you do the **Triangle Dance**? Try it with members of your family! Hint: there are 3 jumps and each of you jump either forward, right or left at the same time! Watch this video to help you! 😊 [The Triangle Dance - Moose Tube | GoNoodle - Bing video](#)
