Live Lessons (via Teams)

English: I look forward to you joining us for English at:

9.15am or 9.45am

Today we will be writing the next two paragraphs.

Follow up activity after lesson:

Click on 26.1.21 English independent task if you want to use the model paragraphs to help you with your writing of your own paragraphs. You will need your boxing plan for this lesson. We will look at examples of another couple of paragraphs and have a go at writing our own versions together. Then, you will have a go at writing your own versions of the paragraphs we have looked at. You can use the model to help you changing some of the words or if you are confident, you can write your own.

Maths: I look forward to you joining us for maths at:

10.15 or 10.45

Today we are working on multiplying by 10, 100 and 1000.

Follow-up activity after lesson:

Click on 26.1.21 Maths independent task. Have a go at either the bronze, silver or gold questions like you would in class. You don't have to print them out, just write your answers on a piece of paper. There is also a challenge to try if you want to. After you have had a go at the questions, you or an adult can mark them. Anything you aren't sure about we can go through tomorrow.

Science: I look forward to you joining us at:

1.15 or 1.45

Today we will be learning about the effects of water resistance.

Follow-up activity after lesson:

Click on 26.1.21 Science independent task. You will need any modelling junk (paper, cardboard box, plastic tubs, egg cartons etc) to make small boats for your investigation. You will also need a piece of paper, some tape and something to record time with. You will be making 2 boats. Think about how you can make them streamline to move as quickly as possible. You will be timing your boats on how quickly they move across water. The quicker they go, the more streamline they are.

Spellings

This week's Spellings are: **profession, programme, pronunciation, queue and recognise.**

Practise writing your spellings in as many different ways as you can eg: writing, drawing, typing, with sticks, chalk, paint, pens. Why not have a go at one of the activities below?

Etch-a-word – Use an Etch-a-sketch to write words. Read the words to someone in your house before easing.

Goofy Spelling Story – Write a goofy spelling story using each of your spelling words. Be sure to underline our words as you use them. Illustrate and colour your story.

Reading

Read for at least 10 minutes. It could be a chapter of a book, a magazine, a newspaper, a recipe or instruction book, an information book etc. You choose!

60 Second Speed Reading Challenge!
Choose your challenge – bronze or silver/gold.

Set a timer on a phone or use a clock and look at the second hand. Give yourself 60 seconds to read the text.

Then give yourself 5 minutes to answer the questions.

Be Active

Have a go at one of these activities:

Speed Bounce Grid Challenge - Test your speed and agility with the Speed Bounce Grid and see how many jumps you can do in 20 seconds!

Activity Snakes and Ladders – Play the game and keep fit at the same time! When you land on certain squares, you need to complete the challenge! See resource on the website.




Once you have finished, check how you got on by marking it with the answers on the website.
