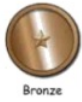


# Can I use emotive language?

Include well chosen adjectives and powerful  
verbs to show how Billy was feeling.



Consider the order of the subordinate clause  
in a sentence to emphasise that Billy was afraid

**Synonyms for scared** Common Informal

*adj* frightened

afraid	panicked	petrified	aghast	terror-stricken
anxious	panicky	shaken	having cold feet	
fearful	startled	terrified	panic-stricken	

**Antonyms for scared**

bold	cool	happy	confident
brave	courageous	unafraid	encouraged

At that moment, he could hear their  
voices ringing in his ears like a  
thousand bells.



Afraid, he ran from the echoing sound



Clutching the snapdragon, Billy ran  
across the sand, round the river and  
up the hill



till he found the door that took him  
back to his own world.



Don't forget to show, not tell,
