<p>English: free writing - Using the internet go on to Pobble 365. See what the image is for today and use it to inspire you to write a story. Don't forget your capital letters and punctuation!</p> <p>Recycling - To help to keep pupils entertained while learning at home, 'Norfolk Recycles' have put together some fun, environmentally themed activity sheets, Find out about recycling, go on a compost creature hunt, try cooking with leftovers or create a single-use sea creature.</p> <p>Do a different activity each day! Today = Activity 3 – Food Waste. (Resources on school website in Monday 25th folder!)</p> <p>Well-Being: Time Table Thursday!– Set up a bingo grid on the floor using numbers written on scrap paper or sticky notes. You could go up to 10 for pre-school children or make it more challenging with higher numbers for bigger ones! With a family member, take it in turns to call out a number and set a physical challenge for the other person to complete e.g. 7 star jumps, 6 bunny hops. Switch over after each go.</p>
