With your family, tick off each time one of you makes a small change. Keep track of who makes the most changes each week!</li> <li>2) Write a poem about a world in which we solve all of the environmental issues that Jess talks about in her book. Begin your poem with the words, 'Imagine a world'</li> <li>3) Create a storyboard showing step-by-step a time when you helped make the world a better place for humans/animals/ environment. Underneath your sketches, write a few words explaining what is happening at that stage in the story.</li> <li>4) Write a letter to a friend or family member telling them how they can make difference and help 'Protect the Planet'</li> <li>5) Design a poster showing ways we can protect the planet</li> </ol>
